## Dearman Technology Centre Joining Instructions



### Unit 5, Stafford Cross Business Park, Stafford Road, Croydon, CR0 4TU

#### By Road

**SatNav:** The postcode CR0 4TU will take you to the correct location. The entrance to the business park, which is on the south side of Stafford Road, is marked by the large Halfords Autocentre building. Dearman is at the far end of the park on the right, our liquid nitrogen tank and Dearman sign are both readily visible.

**From Central London:** Take the A23 southbound, turn right into Stafford Road at the Fiveways junction. Morrisons supermarket is a landmark on this junction.

**From the M25:** Take the M23 exit and select the fork signposted northbound to Croydon. Most SatNavs will direct you straight up the A23 Purley Way to the Fiveways junction with Stafford Road.

#### By Rail

**From Central London:** Outer London trains serve nearby Waddon Station from Victoria, Waterloo and Clapham Junction, with a journey time of circa 30 minutes. From Waddon station we are a 10-minute walk – turn right upon exit, cross the Purley Way toward Morrisons supermarket, bear left (south) to the Stafford Road then turn right (west) onto it. Cross at the crossing point just before the Halfords Autocentre which marks the entrance to the business park, which is on the south side of Stafford Road.

An alternative is to take a train to East Croydon station, which is served by more frequent trains from Victoria, London Bridge and Clapham Junction; take a taxi or bus as directed below.

**From the South:** East Croydon station is served by trains on the Brighton mainline and other lines from the southern counties, including many trains that stop at Gatwick Airport – but note that the non-stop Gatwick Express does not stop there.

From East Croydon station, take the exit at the southern extremity of the platforms, NOT the bridge over the middle. Your simplest option is to take a taxi, turn left at the top of the platform exit ramps. Journey time is 10 minutes, cost is typically £7-£10 one-way (2015).

#### By Bus

The 154 bus travels direct to our location, every 12 minutes. To find this bus, exit East Croydon station and turn right along beside the tramway, crossing it where convenient before continuing in the same direction. When you arrive at Park Avenue, turn left; you will usually see a row of parked buses, you need Stop KA which is at the far end, outside the Fairfield Hall. The 154 will usually be signposted Morden. Alight at The Chase, which is the second stop after the Fiveways junction on Stafford Road. This is at the entrance to the business park which is on the south side of Stafford Road.

#### By Air

Dearman is most readily reached from London Gatwick Airport. You may either take a taxi direct (circa 30-45 minutes journey), or take a train to East Croydon and follow the rail directions “From the South” above.

From Heathrow, Stanstead or Luton airports, you are advised to use rail and underground connections through London and continue to Waddon or East Croydon as directed “From Central London” above.
